



#9 Gift Card Holder

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Supplies (All supplies Stampin' Up! unless noted.)

- **Card stock:** Old Olive CS #100702, Letters to Santa DSP #122349, Early Espresso CS #119686
- **Accessories:** Simply Scored Scoring Tool #122334, Corner Punch #119871, Sticky Strip #104294, Snail Adhesive #104332, Postage Stamp Punch #122344, Scallop Square Punch #119884, Dimensionals #104430, Velcro square (Non Stampin! Up item.)
- **Ribbon:** Celery Taffeta Ribbon #119963, Early Espresso 1/8" taffeta Ribbon #119959

Cutting Measurements

- Old Olive CS: 6-1/4 x 4-1/4
- Letters to Santa DSP: 4-1/4 x 1-1/4 and a large enough scrap to punch with the Postage Stamp Punch.
- Early Espresso CS: Large enough to punch Scallop Square.

Instructions

Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.

1. Score Old Olive card stock at 1-3/4 and 4-1/4. Fold along score lines. Round the corners of the flap using the Corner Punch.
2. Attach Letters to Santa DSP to flap using Snail Adhesive.
3. Place Sticky Strip along the sides of the Gift Card Holder then fold to seal the sides of the holder.
4. Peel off the adhesive back of a small square of Velcro and center on the inside flap. Peel off the second piece adhesive and close the flap. This will ensure both sides of the Velcro line up perfectly.
5. Punch a piece of Letters to Santa DSP using the Postage Stamp Punch.
6. Punch a piece of Early Espresso card stock using the Scallop Square Punch.
7. Use Dimensionals to adhere Letters to Santa DSP Postage Stamp punch to Early Espresso Scallop Square punch.
8. Place both the Celery Taffeta Ribbon and the Early Espresso 1/8" Taffeta Ribbon under the Gift Card Holder flap and tie into a decorative knot. Trim the ribbon ends.
9. Run Snail Adhesive along the top half of the decorative punched scallop square unit and attach to front of Gift Card Holder.
10. Your Gift Card Holder is completeEnjoy!
