Supplies (All supplies Stampin' Up! unless noted.)

- Bright Hopes Stamp Set W#122690 or C#122692, Winter Post Stamp Set #111780
- **Ink:** White Craft Ink #101731, Soft Suede Ink #115657, Champagne Mist Shimmer Paint #116806
- **Card stock:** Brown packing paper from a Stampin' Up! order, Crumb Cake CS #120953, Very Vanilla CS #101650, Soft Suede CS #115318
- **Accessories:** Scallop Square Die #115950, Big Shot Die Cut Machine #113439, Sticky Strip Adhesive #104294, Sponges #101610, 1-3/4 Circle Punch #119850, 2-3/8 Scallop Circle Punch #118874, Dimensionals #104430, Paper Piercer #116631, Color Catcher #121093
- **Ribbon:** Soft Suede Striped Ribbon #125060, Linen Thread #104199

Cutting Measurements

- Brown Packing Paper: 5 inch strips.
- Crumb Cake CS: Large enough piece for Scallop Square die cut.
- Very Vanilla CS: Large enough for stamped sentiment.
- Soft Suede CS: Large enough for 2-3/8 Scallop Circle Punch.

Instructions

Please read instructions all the way through before you begin.

- 1.** Place 5" strip of Brown packing paper onto Scallop Square Die so that the fold is just above the bottom scallop. (You don't want it to cut through the fold.) Place the cutting board on top and then a shim. Run through the Big Shot Die Cut Machine. Repeat using Crumb Cake card stock.
- 2.** Ink the snowflake stamp from the Bright Hopes Stamp Set with White Craft Ink and stamp onto brown packing paper die cut in a random pattern.
- 3.** Run Snail Adhesive on the Crumb Cake card stock and adhere to the back of the Reindeer Food Holder.
- 4.** Place Sticky Strip Adhesive along three edges of the Reindeer Food Holder. Remove the adhesive backing on the two sides, leaving the top strip intact. Seal the sides. Add Reindeer Food to the holder, (Oatmeal and Cookie Sprinkles), then remove the adhesive backing and seal the top.
- 5.** Sponge the edges with Soft Suede Ink.
- 6.** Ink the reindeer stamp from the Winter Post Stamp Set with Soft Suede Ink and stamp onto Very Vanilla card stock.
- 7.** Punch out the stamped reindeer using the 1-3/4 Circle Punch, then sponge the edges using Soft Suede Ink.
- 8.** Use the 2-3/8 Scallop Circle Punch to punch Soft Suede card stock. Apply Dimensionals to the back of the stamped image and adhere to the Soft Suede Scallop Circle.
- 9.** Use the Paper Piercer to pierce a hole in the top of the Soft Suede Scallop Circle.
- 10.** Wrap the Soft Suede Striped Ribbon around the holder and tie in a decorative knot. Trim the ribbon ends.
- 11.** Attach stamped sentiment to the front of the food holder with Linen Thread.
- 12.** Place the Reindeer Food Holder in the Color Catcher and spray with Champagne Mist Shimmer Paint.
- 13.** Your Reindeer Food Holder is completeEnjoy!
